La Jenny

La Jenny is a large self catering naturist resort that is located on the south west coast of France, close to Bordeaux. The resort opened its doors in 1983 and is extremely popular with families who like the 300 acres of space and open grounds.

Facilities include

- large outdoor swimming pool
- kid's club
- tennis courts
- supermarket
- restaurant, pizzeria and bar

Close by is a beautiful sandy beach reached by walking or cycling through a pine forest (bicycle hire on site). There is good surf for the active amongst us.



The following activities are also available (subject to demand): gymnastics, yoga, archery, aerobics, keep-fit, water polo, concerts, dances and shows. Tennis lessons, diving lessons in the pool, sauna, fitness centre, and baby-sitting are available at a nominal charge, as are golfing and golf lessons on a 4-hole training course.

The self catering accommodation is in studios, apartments and a range of bungalows – Some bungalows sleep a maximum of 6 persons. The season at this resort runs from May to September.



Club Oasis

A naturist resort in South West France. Situated next to Aphrodite village, and with full use of its facilities, Club Oasis is close to the beach. Facilities include a

large swimming pool centrally located next to the restaurant and bar, tennis court.

Accommodation is self-catering apartments close to the beach, that sleep from 2 to 6 persons.



Aphrodite

A quiet naturist village in the Roussillon area of the South of France. The resort is located on a four-mile strip of land surrounded by sandy beaches and a large salt lake.

A self contained village, including a shop, restaurant, take away, boutique for souvenirs, newsagents and laundry. The season runs from early June to mid-September. A post office, further shops and bistros can be found year-round in the old village of Leucate, some four miles away.



Facilities include a fresh-water swimming pool, three tennis courts, a boating marina and windsurfing. There is textile horse riding and sailing at nearby Port Leucate.

Accommodation is self-catering studios and apartments that sleep from 2 to 6 persons.



Cap D'Agde

The largest most popular naturist resort in the world located in the South of France. A naturist "town" complete with supermarkets, restaurants, bars, cafes, hairdressers, boutiques, delicatessens, butchers, bakers, post office, bank, cashpoints, and doctors. Cap D'Agde comes alive throughout July & August with hedonistic naturists descending upon the resort. It boasts of many clubs within the region and is very popular with returning visitors year after year.

A short walk along the beach from Cap D'Agde, watersports enthusiasts can enjoy windsurfing, parascending etc. Also tennis courts and golf close by. The historical town of Agde offers many fine boutiques, restaurants and museums.

Self catering accommodation ranges from studios sleeping 2 persons to villas sleeping 5-6 persons. The season at this resort runs from May to September.
